

Club Competitions

- Entry for competitions will be £4.00 which includes 2`s. There will be no sweep at present to prevent the handling of cash.
- The entry fee will be automatically debited from your bar card.
- The competition computer in the hallway is OUT OF USE
- To enter the competition you must register before you play by signing the entry sheet that will be on the sign- in table alongside the daily start sheet. If you are going to enter once the Pro shop has closed then you must send an e-mail to secretary@warehamgolfclub.com in advance so Jon can register you.
- DO NOT exchange scorecards with your playing partner, mark your partner`s scores and your own marker`s score as normal, but only the marker`s signature on each card is required.
- If you finish before the clubhouse closes then put your completed cards in the normal comp box by the computer. If you finish after the clubhouse closes, put completed cards in the new comp box on the outside wall by the main back door.
- Completed cards will be “quarantined” in the comp boxes for 48 hours and Jon will then enter all scores in to the computer and post the results on HOWDIDIDO. This is when the entry fee will be taken from your card.
- Winnings will be credited to your bar cards, 2`s to your Pro Shop account.

Local Rules

The following local rule has to be in use when playing competitions.

Bunkers

Local Rule – Preferred Lies in Bunkers

When a player's ball lies in a part of a bunker *[or identify specific bunker such as “all greenside bunkers”]*, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
- Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: 6 inches from the reference point, **but** with these limits:
- Limits on Location of Relief Area:
 - Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and
 - Must be in the bunker.
 - The area **MUST NOT** be smoothed before placing

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.

Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a."
