Bar, Restaurant and Clubhouse Re-opening

Following the latest lifting of restrictions, bars and restaurants can re-open from the 4th July. Businesses must assess the risks and do everything practicable to minimise them. We have produced this opening guide for all members, guests and staff to follow.

If any member or visitor is feeling unwell, or showing symptoms of Covid 19, then they must stay at home and not attend the golf club.

Please maintain social distancing of 2 metres at all times.

The bar will be open every day, from 10am Monday – Friday, and from 8am Saturday and Sunday. The bar will close at 9pm latest, but it will be earlier if it is a quiet day.

Initially we will have the kitchen open on a Wednesday and Friday from 10am – 3pm, and on Saturday and Sunday from 8am – 3pm. Again, if it is a quiet day, the kitchen may close earlier.

We will be running a limited menu while we get back up and running.

The opening days and times will be under constant review.

Locker Rooms and Toilets.

- Members will have access to the changing rooms and toilets, and lockers will be back in use. **The showers will remain out of use.** We ask that do not congregate in the locker rooms, be in and out as quickly as possible, and to keep contact of surfaces to a minimum. The clubhouse will not have set closing times, so you may not be able to gain access to the locker rooms in the evenings if the clubhouse closes early.
- Even if access to a locker is required, golfers are still encouraged to change their shoes in the car park.
- To help maintain distancing and to avoid congestion in the changing rooms, men are encouraged to still use the disabled toilet when possible.

Clubhouse, Bar and Restaurant

- **ENTRY** in to the bar area is via the internal door leading from the foyer **ONLY**.
- **EXIT** from the bar is via the double patio doors **ONLY** (except in the case of fire when the normal fire exits will be in use)
- To comply with government contact tracing requirements all non-golfers **must** sign-in leave a contact number in visitors' book situated on the table as you enter the bar area. We will rely on the booking system and golf registration book (for golfing visitors) to know which golfers were present at the course on any day.

- Everyone is encouraged to use the hand sanitiser provided as you enter the clubhouse. There are numerous hand sanitiser stations in the clubhouse, pro shop and hallway.
- We will not be providing a table service; place your orders at the bar as normal, but it is only **1 person at the bar at a time**. An area will be marked on the floor in front of the bar to show where customers have to stand when placing orders. There will be a screen in place between the customer and bar staff. Please do not lean on the bar.
- If you enter the clubhouse as a group we ask that you sit down and only 1 of the group comes to the bar to place the order.
- Please observe distancing rules when queueing i.e. 2 metres
- Please use contactless payment where possible. Members can use their bar cards by giving the bar staff their name – there is no need to hand over your bar card.
- Once the order is taken, drinks will be placed at the end of the bar for you to take; orders of more than 2 drinks will be placed on a tray so that you don't have to return to the bar.
- If you order food or teas/coffees, you will be given a numbered ticket. Once the order is ready, it food will be placed on a table inside the clubhouse and your ticket number announced, you can then collect your food. Food can also be ordered to takeaway, and collected in the same way.
- When you are ready to vacate your table, please leave all glasses, plates, cutlery and condiments where they are. The staff will then clear the table, clean and sanitise ready for the next customers.
- When you are looking for somewhere to sit, **PLEASE DO NOT SIT AT A TABLE THAT HAS NOT BEEN CLEARED**. It needs to be thoroughly cleaned and sanitised first. Please be patient as the bar and kitchen staff will need longer than normal to clean and clear.
- Tables and chairs have been positioned specifically to maintain social distancing, with a maximum of 4 people around each table. **TABLES AND CHAIRS MUST NOT BE MOVED TO FORM LARGER GROUPS.**

Patio and Decking Area

- Customers are encouraged to use the outside space as much as possible. All of the guidance listed above applies to the patio tables and benches.
- If you are sitting outside and need to get back in to the clubhouse/bar, you must go through the internal door, NOT back through the patio doors.
- Do not congregate in groups of more than 6, always maintaining a 2 metre distance where possible.
