## Members' Privacy Statement

References to **we**, **our** or **us** in this privacy notice are to the Wareham Golf Club Limited.

We are committed to respecting your privacy. This notice is to explain how we may use personal information we collect before, during and after your membership with us. This notice applies to you if you have registered to become or are a member of our club. This notice explains how we comply with the law on data protection, what your rights are and, for the purposes of data protection, we will be the controller of any of your personal information.

We have not appointed a Data Protection Officer to oversee our compliance with data protection laws as we not required to do so, but our Board of Directors has overall responsibility for data protection compliance in our organisation.

### 1. PERSONAL INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

Depending on the type of membership you register for with us, you may provide us with or we may obtain **personal information** about you, such as information regarding your:

- personal details that allows us to contact you directly such as name, title, email addresses and telephone numbers
- date of birth
- gender
- membership start and end date
- records of your interactions with us such as telephone conversations, emails and other correspondence and your instructions to us
- any bank account, credit/debit card and other payment details you provide so that we can receive payments from you
- details of the financial transactions with you
- use of and movements through our online portal, passwords, personal identification numbers, IP addresses, user names and other IT system identifying information;
- records of your attendance at any events hosted by us;
- CCTV footage and other information obtained through electronic means such as swipecard
- your marketing preferences so that we know whether and how we should contact you.
- details of next of kin, family members, coaches and emergency contacts;
- handicapping and scoring recorded
- any disciplinary and complaints information;

### 2. WHERE WE COLLECT YOUR INFORMATION

We typically collect personal information about our members when:

- you apply to become a member of the club,
- when you apply to pay your annual subscription by direct debit
- when you pay for any service provided by us

- scoring and handicapping data when you enter and play in a competition

You may provide us with details of next of kin, beneficiaries, family members and emergency contacts and they have a right to know and to be aware of how what personal information we hold about them, how we collect it and how we use and may share that information. Please share this privacy notice with those of them whom you feel are sufficiently mature to understand it. They also have the same rights as set out in the “**Your rights in relation to personal information**” section below.

### USES MADE OF THE INFORMATION

The table below describes the main purposes for which we process your personal information, the categories of your information involved and our lawful basis for being able to do this.

To send you information which is included within your membership benefits package, including details about, competitions and events, partner offers and discounts and any updates on Golf	Contact and membership details.	Legitimate interest necessary to enable us to properly manage and administer your membership contract with us .
To answer your queries or complaints	Contact details and records of your interactions with us	We have a legitimate interest to provide complaint handling services to you in case there are any issues with your membership.

The security of our IT systems	All the personal information we collect and hold on our IT administrative systems. Access to your data by staff and directors is limited to what they a required to have in order to do fulfil the contracts we have with you. Access is regulated by defined user profiles and passwords	<p>We have a legitimate interest to ensure that our IT systems are secure.</p> <p>We process special category personal data on the basis of the “special category reasons for processing of your personal data” referred to in section 2 above.</p>
To conduct data analytics studies to better understand event attendance and trends within the sport	Records of your attendance at any events or competitions hosted by us.	We have a legitimate interest in doing so to ensure that our membership is targeted and relevant.
For the purposes of promoting the club, our events and membership packages.	Images in video and/or photographic form.	Where you have given us your explicit consent to do so.
To comply with health and safety requirements	Records of attendance, CCTV footage and other information obtained through electronic means such as swipecard, medical information about your health	We have a legal obligation and a legitimate interest to provide you and other members of our organisation with a safe environment in which to participate in sport

For some of your personal information you will have a legal, contractual or other requirement or obligation for you to provide us with your personal information. If you do not provide us

with the requested personal information we may not be able to admit you as a member or we may not be able to properly perform our contract with you or comply with legal obligations and we may have to terminate your membership. For other personal information you may not be under an obligation to provide it to us, but if you do not provide it then we may not be able to properly perform our contract with you.

Where you have given us your consent to use your personal information in a particular manner, you have the right to withdraw this consent at any time, which you may do by contacting us as described in the "Contacting us" section below.

Please note however that the withdrawal of your consent will not affect any use of the data made before you withdrew your consent and we may still be entitled to hold and process the relevant personal information to the extent that we are entitled to do so on bases other than your consent. Withdrawing consent may also have the same effects as not providing the information in the first place, for example we may no longer be able to provide certain member benefits to you.

### 3. DIRECT MARKETING

**Email, post and SMS marketing:** from time to time, we or our golf and catering partners may contact you by email, post or SMS with information about products and services we believe you may be interested in. However, these will only relate to golf events/products and social events.

We will not permit third parties to use your data for marketing purposes

### 4. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may share personal information with the following parties:

- Any party approved by you.
- Third parties who provide services to us which are essential to the delivery of your membership contract with us e.g direct debit bureau, on-line tee booking providers
- To any governing bodies or regional bodies for the sports covered by our club: to allow them to properly administer the sports on a local, regional and national level. This will include England Golf World Handicap System (WHS)
- The Government or our regulators: where we are required to do so by law or to assist with their investigations or initiatives.

- Police, law enforcement and security services: to assist with the investigation and prevention of crime and the protection of national security.

### 5. TRANSFERRING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION INTERNATIONALLY

The personal information we collect is not transferred to and stored in countries outside of the UK and the European Union.

### 6. HOW LONG DO WE KEEP PERSONAL INFORMATION FOR?

The duration for which we retain your personal information will differ depending on the type of information and the reason why we collected it from you. However, in some cases personal information may be retained on a long-term basis: for example, personal information that we need to retain for legal purposes will normally be retained in accordance with usual commercial practice and regulatory requirements. Generally, where there is no legal requirement we retain all physical and electronic records for a period of 6 years after your last contact with us or the end of your membership. Exceptions to this rule are:

- CCTV records which are held for no more than 30 days unless we need to preserve the records for the purpose of prevention and detection of crime;
- Details regarding unsuccessful membership applicants where we hold records for a period of not more than 12 months;
- Information that may be relevant to personal injury or discrimination claims may be retained until the limitation period for those types of claims has expired. For personal injury or discrimination claims this can be an extended period as the limitation period might not start to run until a long time after the event.

It is important to ensure that the personal information we hold about you is accurate and up-to-date, and you should let us know if anything changes, for example if you change your phone number or email address. You may be able to update some of the personal information we hold about you through our website. Alternatively, you can contact us by using the details set out in the “**Contacting us**” section below.

### 7. YOUR RIGHTS IN RELATION TO PERSONAL INFORMATION

You have the following rights in relation to your personal information:

- the right to be informed about how your personal information is being used;
- the right to access the personal information we hold about you;
- the right to request the correction of inaccurate personal information we hold about you;
- the right to request the erasure of your personal information in certain limited circumstances;

- the right to restrict processing of your personal information where certain requirements are met;
- the right to object to the processing of your personal information;
- the right to request that we transfer elements of your data either to you or another service provider; and
- the right to object to certain automated decision-making processes using your personal information.

You should note that some of these rights, for example the right to require us to transfer your data to another service provider or the right to object to automated decision making, may not apply as they have specific requirements and exemptions which apply to them and they may not apply to personal information recorded and stored by us. For example, we do not use automated decision making in relation to your personal data. However, some have no conditions attached, so your right to withdraw consent or object to processing for direct marketing are absolute rights.

Whilst this privacy notice sets out a general summary of your legal rights in respect of personal information, this is a very complex area of law. More information about your legal rights can be found on the Information Commissioner's website at <https://ico.org.uk/for-the-public/>.

To exercise any of the above rights, or if you have any questions relating to your rights, please contact us by using the details set out in the "Contacting us" section below.

If you are unhappy with the way we are using your personal information you can also complain to the UK Information Commissioner's Office or your local data protection regulator. We are here to help and encourage you to contact us to resolve your complaint first.

### **8. CHANGES TO THIS NOTICE**

We may update this privacy notice from time to time. When we change this notice in a material way, we will update the version date at the bottom of this page. For significant changes to this notice we will try to give you reasonable notice unless we are prevented from doing so. Where required by law we will seek your consent to changes in the way we use your personal information.
